SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII TO DEVELOP A PLAN THAT
OUTLINES COORDINATION AMONG UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII CAMPUSES
IN INCREASING ONLINE COURSES.

1 WHEREAS, online courses and degree programs are
2 increasingly important to ensure access to education for many
3 students; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the geography of Hawaii makes online and distance
6 education options especially valuable in the State, both for
7 local and out-of-state students; and
8

9 WHEREAS, students on neighbor islands are in particular
10 need of affordable, high quality distance education options; and
11

12 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii offers only two fully
13 online degree programs, in contrast to sixteen online degree
14 programs offered at comparable institutions; and
15

16 WHEREAS, some universities offer significantly more online
17 degree programs, such as East Carolina University, which offers
18 over seventy-five online degree programs, and Penn State, which
19 offers over one hundred online degree programs; and

21 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii is well situated to offer
22 a unique and valuable perspective to local and out-of-state
23 students in a variety of important subject areas, including
24 oceanography, renewable energy, and climate change; and

26 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii has been a national
27 leader in providing distance education options to students in
28 the past; now, therefore,

30 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-eighth
31 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2016,
32 that the University of Hawaii is requested to develop a plan
33 that outlines cooperation amongst the University of Hawaii
34 campuses in increasing online courses and degree programs; and
