Your Committee has reviewed the personal history, resume, and statement submitted by the nominee and finds Tammie Napoleon to possess the requisite qualifications to be nominated to the State Board of Nursing.

Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination of Tammie Napoleon from the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs and seven individuals.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that Dr. Napoleon's background, experience, and commitment to her profession qualify her for appointment to the State Board of Nursing as a licensee member. Your Committee notes that Dr. Napoleon has been a licensed registered nurse in Hawaii since 1998, an advanced practice registered nurse since 2007, and recently completed her doctorate of nursing practice. Dr. Napoleon has been a nursing educator since 2005, currently serves as an Associate Professor of Nursing and the Health Education Division Chair at Kauai Community College, and her experience in a variety of health care settings and perspective as
