Your Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce, to which
was referred H.B. No. 1028 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PROCUREMENT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to authorize the chief
procurement officer to establish a special innovative procurement
process to provide the State with greater flexibility in the
procurement of certain goods and services to meet unique or
unusual needs or situations while maintaining the accountability
and transparency afforded by the State Procurement Code.

The State Procurement Office, Department of Agriculture, and
Uluono Initiative testified in support of this measure. The
Department of Transportation and American Council of Engineering
Companies of Hawaii provided comments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by making technical,
nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce that is attached to
this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and
purpose of H.B. No. 1028, as amended herein, and recommends that
it be referred to the Committee on Finance in the form attached
hereto as H.B. No. 1028, H.D. 1.
