Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 1108 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HEALTH,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to mandate insurance coverage for treatments of autism spectrum disorders for persons 18 years of age and under.

Autism Speaks; Community Children's Council of Hawaii;
National Association of Social Workers, Hawaii Chapter; and
numerous individuals supported this measure. The Hawaii
Psychological Association and two individuals supported this
measure with suggested amendments. The State Council on
Developmental Disabilities, Easter Seals Hawaii, Kaiser Permanente
Hawaii, Special Education Advisory Council, and a few individuals
supported the intent of this measure. Hawaii Medical Service
Association opposed this measure. The Department of Health,
Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, Hawaii Disability
Rights Center, Autism Society, The Chamber of Commerce of Hawaii,
and several individuals commented on this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

(1) Changing the age of eligibility for the treatment of autism spectrum disorders to 21 years of age or under;

- (2) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2050, to facilitate further discussion; and
- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for style, clarity, and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 1108, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 1108, H.D. 1, and be referred to the Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce.
