OF HONOLULU,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to strengthen law-enforcement
efforts by appropriating funds to restore currently unfunded
positions and the capacity to provide the full array of services
required of the Career Criminal Prosecution Unit and Victim
Witness Assistance Program of the Department of the Prosecuting
Attorney of the City and County of Honolulu.

The Department of the Attorney General, Crime Victim
Compensation Commission, Department of the Prosecuting Attorney of
the City and County of Honolulu, Office of the Prosecuting
Attorney of the County of Hawaii, Department of the Prosecuting
Attorney of the County of Maui, Office of the Prosecuting Attorney
of the County of Kauai, and a concerned individual supported the
measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by inserting blank
appropriation amounts and changing the effective date to July 1,
2030, to encourage further discussion. Technical, nonsubstantive
amendments for clarity, consistency, and style were also made.


