Your Committee on Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred H.B. No. 2179 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE AHA MOKU ADVISORY COMMITTEE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds for the administration and operation of the Aha Moku Advisory Committee and for community outreach.

The Aha Moku Advisory Committee, the Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs, Kauai Wildlife Reserve, Marine and Coastal Zone Advocacy Council, Ko'olaupoko Hawaiian Civic Club, and numerous individuals tesified in support of this measure. The Department of Land and Natural Resources supported this measure with comments.

Your Committee amended the measure by:

- Changing the appropriation amount for administrative and operational expenses of the Aha Moku Advisory Committee from \$250,000 to an unspecified amount;
- (2) Changing the appropriation amount for community outreach efforts of the Aha Moku Advisory Committee from \$250,000 to an unspecified amount; and
- (3) Changing the effective date of the measure to December24, 2088 to encourage further discussion.
