The purpose and intent of this measure is to ensure that the
Executive Office on Early Learning has the necessary staffing and
support to ensure a solid foundation for Hawaii's young children
by appropriating funds for:

- (1) Travel for the Early Learning Advisory Board to attend
meetings;
- (2) A secretary IV position; and
- (3) A research statistician IV position.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Executive Office on Early Learning, State Charter School
Commission, Hawaii State Teachers Association, Kamehameha Schools,
HE'E Coalition, Hawaii Children's Action Network, Chamber of
Commerce Hawaii, and two individuals.

Your Committee finds that the Executive Office on Early
Learning's mission is to ensure a solid foundation for Hawaii's
young children, prenatal to age five, by working with partners,
families, and communities and connecting policies, programs, and
funding in relation to health, safety, early childhood education,

and school readiness and success. Adequate support for infrastructure and staffing is vital to the Executive Office on Early Learning's ability to accomplish that mission.
