Your Committee on Housing, to which was referred H.B. No. 2623 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to authorize the Hawaii Public Housing Authority to evict a tenant from a public housing project if the tenant is convicted of a felony related to the Authority's property or funds.

The Hawaii Public Housing Authority and a concerned individual supported this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- Allowing the Hawaii Public Housing Authority to also evict a tenant from a public housing project if the tenant is convicted of a misdemeanor related to the Authority's property or funds;
- (2) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2050, to facilitate further discussion; and
- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.
