Your Committees on Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian Affairs and Water & Land, to which was referred H.B. No. 629 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE PAPAHANAUMOKUAKEA MARINE NATIONAL MONUMENT,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to establish the Papahanaumokuakea Marine National Monument (Monument) Program, to be placed within the Office of the Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources, to coordinate and fulfill the State's role and responsibilities in co-managing the Monument. Specifically, this measure, among other things:

- Allows the Monument Program to issue permits consistent with applicable state laws and Presidential Proclamation 8031, which established the Monument;
- (2) Allows the Department of Land and Natural Resources to charge fees that are proportional to the nature and complexity of the projects or services to be performed by the Monument Program; and
- (3) Establishes penalty provisions applicable to Monument Program violations.
