Your Committee on Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian  
Affairs, to which was referred H.B. No. 720 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE WEST MAUI OCEAN RECREATION  
MANAGEMENT AREA,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to make permanent the West  
Maui Ocean Recreation Management Area Advisory Committee and to  
add one member with a background in ocean safety.

Several concerned individuals supported this measure. The  
Department of Land and Natural Resources, Kaanapali Kai Charters,  
Ocean Tourism Coalition, Quicksilver Charters, and Frogman  
Charters opposed this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Deleting the Advisory Committee members' exemption from  
Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as it applies only  
in the case of a temporary committee; and
- (2) Changing the effective date to December 24, 2088, to  
facilitate further discussion.


As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your


