Sir:

Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 1155, S.D. 2, H.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE CREATIVE MEDIA INDUSTRY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to more efficiently allocate the resources that support Hawaii's creative media industry. Specifically, this measure, among other things:

- Assigns to the Hawaii Tourism Authority the responsibilities for film development and marketing;
- Transfers the Film Industry Branch of the Creative Industries Division of the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism to the Hawaii Tourism Authority; and
- (3) Establishes and appropriates general funds to the Film Development and Marketing Special Fund for implementation of film development and marketing activities by the Hawaii Tourism Authority.

The Hawaii Tourism Authority supported this measure. SAG-AFTRA Hawaii Local, I.A.T.S.E. Local 665, and the American Federation of Musicians' Local 677 opposed this measure. The Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism;
