The purpose and intent of this measure is to support the growth and sustainability of Hawaii's agriculture industry by appropriating funds for the sustainable and organic agriculture program at the University of Hawaii College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources.

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure from the University of Hawaii College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources, Department of Agriculture, Hawaii Farm Bureau Federation, Hawaii Farmers Union United, Hawaii Island School Garden Network, Kanalani Ohana Farm, and twenty-four individuals. Your Committees received testimony in opposition to this measure from Ho'omana Pono, LLC.

Your Committees find that across the State farmers are experimenting with different ways of producing agricultural products in ways that are sustainable and beneficial to the social, economic, and environmental well-being of farm families and rural communities. Your Committees further find that the sustainable and organic agriculture program at the University of Hawaii College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources is committed to increasing awareness and adoption of sustainable and

organic practices across the State while addressing the challenges of creating more profitable farm incomes, environmental stewardship, and stable and prosperous farm communities.
