Affairs, & Culture and the Arts, to which was referred S.B. No.
2256, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVER
LICENSING,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to clarify the authorization
to notate the term "veteran" on a driver's license to include a
veteran of the Korean conflict and those who served in the armed
forces of the Republic of Korea, fought under the command of the
United Nations led by the United States during the Korean
conflict, and is currently a United States citizen.

The Office of Veterans' Services, a member of the City
Council of the City and County of Honolulu, Korean War Veterans
Association Aloha Chapter, and a concerned individual supported
this measure.

Should the Committee on Transportation deliberate on this
measure, your Committee on Veterans, Military, & International
Affairs, & Culture and the Arts respectfully requests that it
consider specifying in this measure that the Director of the
Office of Veterans' Services shall be the party responsible to
certify that the driver license applicant is a veteran of the
armed forces of the Republic of Korea, fought under the command of
the United Nations led by the United States during the Korean
conflict, and is currently a United States citizen.
