Your Committee on Conference on the disagreeing vote of the Senate to the amendments proposed by the House of Representatives in S.B. No. 2680, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS,"

having met, and after full and free discussion, has agreed to recommend and does recommend to the respective Houses the final passage of this bill in an amended form.

The purpose of this measure is to make certain housekeeping amendments within chapter 412, Hawaii Revised Statutes, including:

- (1) Clarifying and addressing inconsistencies within the fee schedule for financial institutions; and
- (2) Repealing the Credit Union Advisory Board.

Your Committee on Conference finds that this measure adds consistency within the fee schedule for financial institutions under chapter 412, Hawaii Revised Statutes. Your Committee on Conference notes that this measure does not add any new fees, but rather

corrects and clarifies references to existing fees. This measure also repeals the Credit Union Advisory Board, as this board has been inactive since 2010 and there are currently no state-chartered credit unions in the State. Your Committee on Conference further finds that this measure makes chapter 412, Hawaii Revised Statutes, easier to understand, reduces questions about fees, and enhances the Division of Financial Institutions' ability to collect fees consistent with the fee schedule.

Your Committee on Conference has amended this measure by:

- (1) Inserting an effective date of upon its approval; and
- (2) Making a technical, nonsubstantive amendment for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the managers of your Committee on Conference that is attached to this report, your Committee on Conference is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2680, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Final Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 2680, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, C.D. 1.
