Your Committees on Health and Education, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 30, S.D. 1, entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENTS OF HEALTH AND EDUCATION TO COLLABORATE ON EDUCATIONAL INFORMATION AND MATERIALS ABOUT THE HUMAN PAPILLOMAVIRUS VACCINE THAT CAN BE PROVIDED TO PARENTS OF PUBLIC MIDDLE AND INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL CHILDREN,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Department of Health and the Department of Education to:

- (1) Collaborate on educational information and materials for distribution about the human papillomavirus vaccine that can be provided to parents of public school children based on recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; and
- (2) Seek and obtain private or federal funding to assist with the financing of the actions requested by this measure.

The Department of Education, Hawaii Youth Services Network, Planned Parenthood Votes Northwest and Hawaii, Hawaii State Democratic Women's Caucus, American Association of University Women- Hawaii, Hawaii Public Health Institute of Hawaii, and
