"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO ENSURE THAT SPECIAL EDUCATION TEACHERS HAVE ADEQUATE TIME TO PLAN AND PREPARE INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR THEIR STUDENTS, "

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to request the Department of Education to ensure that special education teachers have adequate time to plan and prepare individualized education programs for their students.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Hawaii State Teachers Association. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Education.

Your Committee finds that special education teachers must adapt curricula, lesson plans, and other educational materials to the unique needs of individual students. The process of preparing individualized education programs is time consuming. Special education teachers frequently report that they do not have adequate time to prepare these programs. Reducing the workload of special education teachers and giving them more time to prepare individualized education programs will benefit special education students and allow them to more fully take advantage of the educational services and opportunities in Hawaii's schools.
