Your Committees on Education and Economic Development,
Environment, and Technology, to which was referred S.R. No. 109
entitled:

"SENATE RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO
PARTNER SCHOOL COMPLEX AREAS WITH NEIGHBORING INDUSTRIES TO
CREATE K-12 COMPLEX AREA CAREER PATHWAYS,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to encourage the
Department of Education to:

- (1) Partner school complex areas with neighboring industries
to create K-12 complex area career pathways; and
- (2) Plan, design, and construct an applied technology center
at a complex specializing in complex career pathways.

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Education, Hawaii State Teachers
Association, IMUAlliance, and one individual.

Your Committees find that skilled employment related to
science, technology, engineering, and math are in demand, and that
the demand is expected to increase in the future. Research
indicates that highly-skilled job openings are likely to expand in
many fields, including agriculture, cybersecurity, and technology.
Although these job openings require skilled applicants, many of
them do not require a college degree. Your Committees further
find that Hawaii's high schools are well situated to give students




the opportunity to learn skills that will make those students more valuable to local employers upon their graduation. This measure will help provide those opportunities to Hawaii's students.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your Committees on Education and Economic Development, Environment, and Technology that are attached to this report, your Committees concur with the intent and purpose of S.R. No. 109 and recommend that it be referred to your Committee on Ways and Means.
