The purpose and intent of this measure is to urge the

Hawaii's public highways and roads by planting more trees.


Your Committee received written comments in support of this

environment. Trees supply oxygen, help stabilize the soil, lower
air temperatures, and assist in reducing noise pollution.
Additionally, trees and nature are a significant component of the
lush green-image of Hawaii that many tourists expect to experience
upon visiting the State. Many areas along public highways and
roads could be landscaped to include more trees. Your Committee
believes that Hawaii's health, environment, and tourism could
benefit from the planting of additional trees along public
highways and roads.


