DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

HB2707 HD1 (HSCR835-16) Status and Testimony RELATING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA. Establishes the medical marijuana advisory commission. Amends various definitions and provisions relating to medical marijuana dispensary operations, paraphernalia, and testing. Provides that advanced practice registered nurses may certify patients for medical marijuana use. Excludes dispensaries from enterprise zone tax exemptions. Excludes medical marijuana from certain federal tax provisions. Provides that certain University of Hawaii branches may conduct marijuana-related testing and research. Effective 07/01/2070. (HD1)

HB1850 HD1 (HSCR852-16) Status and Testimony RELATING TO TAXATION.

Allows transient accommodations brokers to register as tax collection agents to collect and remit general excise and transient accommodations taxes on behalf of operators and plan managers using their services. (HB1850 HD1)
