HB 2727, HD1 (HSCR951-16) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO MOVIE THEATERS. Requires movie theaters to provide open movie captioning for at least two showings a week and audio descriptions upon request for all movies for which such accommodations are available and to provide public notice if such accommodations are not available for certain movies. HB 2331, HD1 (HSCR666-16) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO BOARD MEMBER TERMS FOR THE BOARD OF NURSING AND THE BOARD OF SPEECH PATHOLOGY AND AUDIOLOGY. Amends the length of terms from three years to four years of the members of the Board of Nursing and the Board of Speech Pathology and Audiology. (HB2331 HD1)	СРН
<u>HB 1096, HD2</u> (HSCR945-16) <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE SECURE AND FAIR ENFORCEMENT FOR MORTGAGE LICENSING ACT. Specifies that mortgage loan originator companies shall be open for business to the public during posted business hours, which at a minimum shall be offered within regular business hours. <u>HB 1541, HD1</u> (HSCR985-16) <u>Status &</u> Testimony	RELATING TO PLANNED COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS. Amends various proxy statement requirements for planned community associations to conform to requirements for other, similar statements. (HB1541 HD1)	CPH
HB 1705 (HSCR937-16) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE. Allows proof of motor vehicle insurance to be displayed in electronic format on a mobile electronic device.	CPH
<u>HB 1708, HD2</u> (HSCR1002-16) <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO MEDICINE AND SURGERY. Authorizes the Hawaii Medical Board to issue a visiting sports physician temporary license to a physician or osteopathic physician who is not licensed in this State under certain circumstances. Requires the Auditor to conduct a study to determine whether licensure for visiting sports physicians is warranted. (HB1708 HD2)	СРН



<u>HB 2482, HD2</u> (HSCR997-16) <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO INSURANCE. Requires managed care plans to provide claims data annually at no charge to a large group purchaser if the large group purchaser requests the information and meets certain requirements. (HB2482 HD2)	СРН
HB 254, HD2 (HSCR853-16) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO MEDICINES. Allows for the dispensing of biosimilar medicines under specified conditions. Regulates interchangeable biological products. (HB254 HD2)	СРН
HB 2169, HD2 (HSCR926-16) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO SOCIAL WORKERS. Authorizes the adoption of rules to clarify the supervision requirements for licensure of clinical social workers, including the criteria for supervision by videoconferencing or other electronic means. (HB2169 HD2)	<u>CPH</u> [Measure added on 03-22-16]
HB 1672, HD2 (HSCR786-16) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO PRESCRIPTION DRUG BENEFITS. Authorizes a beneficiary of a prescription drug benefit plan to obtain a prescription without penalty from a non-network retail community pharmacy located within fourteen miles of the beneficiary's residence, if the nearest network retail community pharmacy is located more than fourteen miles away. (HB1672 HD2)	<u>CPH</u> [Measure added on 03-23-16]
HB 1751, HD2 (HSCR925-16) Status &	RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY. Broadens the definition of renewable energy. (HB1751 HD2)	<u>CPH</u> [Measure added on 03-24-16]
