SB 2040, SD1 (SSCR2520) Status RELATING TO POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION.

Clarifies that under the Hawaii Post-Secondary Education

Authorization Program, when an institution ceases to operate, the student transcripts shall be kept permanently in a form prescribed by the director and other records requested and obtained by DCCA may

be disposed of at the director's discretion. (SD1)

SB 2398, SD2, HD1 (HSCR1109-16) Status RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING.

Authorizes the establishment of public employee collective bargaining units not already specifically authorized in law. Allows part-time and

full-time graduate student assistants employed by UH to collectively bargain their wages, hours, and other terms; provided that no collective bargaining agreement shall take effect prior to July 1, 2017. Requires UH and the relevant exclusive representatives to meet and report to the
