RELATING TO LICENSING INSPECTIONS. SB 2384, SD1 HLT/JUD, FIN

(SSCR2513) Requires the department of health to conduct unannounced visits and Status relicensing or recertification inspections for state-licensed care

facilities and unannounced inspections for license renewals for medical

marijuana dispensaries. (SD1)

SB 2523, SD1 RELATING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA. HLT/JUD, FIN

(SSCR2505) Repeals the requirement that medical marijuana dispensary facilities, except retail dispensing locations, be enclosed indoor facilities. **Status** 

> Allows medical marijuana production centers to be secured greenhouses or shade houses; provided that the contents of the greenhouses or shade houses are not visible from any thoroughfare.

Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)
