Status

Exempts from liability and sanctions persons who are involved in a

patient's participation in experimental treatments for a terminal illness.

HB 254 Status

RELATING TO MEDICINES.

HLT, CPC

Establishes a biosimilars working group to consider issues relating to

the state regulation of biosimilar medicines and to make

recommendations to the legislature.

### **DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW**
