SB 2057 RELATING TO HOUSING. HMS, WAM

Status & Establishes the housing for the homeless special fund and executive office on homeless identity protection to assist homeless individuals with the process, including associated

costs, of obtaining a government-issued identification document.

Makes an appropriation.

SB 3008 RELATING TO MEDICAL ASSISTANCE. HMS, CPH

Status & Requires providers and health plans to gather data regarding homeless individuals' use of medical assistance programs.
