HB 2659 RELATING TO HOUSING. HSG/HUS, FIN

**Status** Requires funds in the dwelling unit revolving fund and the rental

housing revolving fund to be used to provide rent subsidies, loans, or grants to persons who qualify for social security disability benefits and are diagnosed with life-long, serious mental illnesses.

HB 1958 RELATING TO A GENERAL EXCISE TAX EXEMPTION FOR HSG/HUS, FIN

Status LOW INCOME RENTAL SUBSIDIES.

Exempts rental subsidy payments for Section 8 and Housing First

Programs from the state general excise tax.
