(SSCR2491) <u>Status</u>

Repeals section 346-47 and amends sections 457A-1.5, 457A-2, and 457A-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to delete references to the Department of Human Services as licensing or certifying health care

settings; and deletes references to the Department of Human Services investigating and disciplining certified nurse aides employed in health

care settings.
