Status & Amends section 231-18, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to allow Testimony

disclosure of tax return information to the Department of the Attorney General, federal, state, or local officials, and other persons in specified situations; and amends section 235-116, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to clarify that all information filed under chapter 235, Hawaii Revised Statutes, with any state agency is

confidential.

SB 2538 RELATING TO CRIMINAL PROSECUTIONS. JDL, WAM

Status & Provides that the court may appoint one or three qualified examiners to review the fitness of a criminal defendant to proceed in a felony case. Establishes criteria for determining

the number of examiners to appoint. Amends statute formatting.

SB 2880 RELATING TO SERVICES PERFORMED BY CIVIL SERVICE JDL, WAM

Status & EMPLOYEES.

Authorizes establishment of civil service positions and appropriates associated general and non-general funds to enable Executive Branch departments to provide services to the public with civil service employees rather than through
