<a href="#"><u>SB 2112</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO THE USE OF A DOG IN JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS. Authorizes any state court to permit the use of a facility dog in a judicial proceeding involving the testimony of a vulnerable witness if the court determines that there is a compelling necessity for the use of a trained and credential facility dog to facilitate the testimony of a vulnerable witness. <a href="#"><u>SB 3080</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO THEFT. Establishes the offense of theft of urn as a class C felony.	JDL
<a href="#"><u>SB 3036</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT. Clarifies the grounds under which an employer may take employment action without committing a discriminatory practice.	JDL
<a href="#"><u>SB 2600</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO ETHICS. Repeals the standards (1) requiring a liberal interpretation of the state ethics code; and (2) allowing determinations of gifts law violations under the state ethics code to be based upon an inference of impropriety, to instead require a finding of actual intent to influence the recipient of the gift. Requires state ethics commission advisory opinions to be approved and signed by a majority of the commission members. Requires that two of the five members of the state ethics commission be appointed by each chamber of the legislature.	JDL
<a href="#"><u>HB 1726</u></a> <a href="#"><u>(HSCR665-16)</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO MURDER. Provides that first degree murder includes a case in which a victim is used as a shield or held as a hostage or for ransom.	JDL
