HB 2671, HD2 (HSCR862-16) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO CRIMINAL JUSTICE DATA. Requires chiefs of police and state and county agencies that have the power of arrest to report crime incident reports and other crime information to the Attorney General. HB 1907, HD2 (HSCR988-16) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO SEXUAL ASSAULT. Establishes the Sexual Assault Kit Tracking Program in the Honolulu Police Department, including requirements for submission of kits for testing, reporting information to state and federal DNA databases, obtaining consent prior to testing, and admissibility of evidence in judicial proceedings.
