(HSCR824-16) Authorizes the State or a county to obtain ownership over a road WAM

by condemnation pursuant to the State's powers of eminent domain. Exempts the State and counties from maintaining or

HB 2086, HD2 RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. TRE/PSM, WAM

(HSCR971-16)
Amends the statewide transportation plan to include bicycle facilities as part of the transportation system components.

Status & Requires the Department of Transportation to develop a survey on travel behavior. Requires each county to develop

transportation mode sharing plans and to update these plans

every six years beginning in 2019. (HB2086 HD2)

HB 2250, HD1 RELATING TO HIGHWAYS. TRE/PSM, WAM

(HSCR825-16)
Appropriates revenues for repair work and resurfacing of Kalani

Street, Auld Lane, and Rawlins Lane on the island of Oahu.

HB 2490, HD2 RELATING TO VETERANS. PSM/TRE, WAM Exempts certain disabled veterans from county motor vehicle (HSCR907-16) taxes and the state annual vehicle registration fee. (HB2490 Status & HD2) **Testimony** HB 2636, HD2 RELATING TO SOLAR ENERGY FACILITIES. PSM/TRE, WAM Requires a county that meets certain conditions to require solar (HSCR928-16) energy facilities in farm dwellings in agricultural districts with a capacity of more than twenty-five kilowatts to obtain a special Status & Testimony permit. (HB2636 HD2)
