## DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY. SB2738 TRE, WAM Status and Testimony Replaces the current renewable energy technology systems tax credit with tax credits for solar energy property and wind energy property. Requires the Department of Taxation and Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism to report tax credits claimed under the renewable energy technology tax credit and make recommendations to the legislature. <u>SB2604</u> RELATING TO A MICROGRID PILOT PROJECT FOR EDU/TRE, WAM Status and Testimony [Measure added on SCHOOLS. Requires the department of education to establish an off-grid 2/2/2016] microgrid pilot project through the Ka Hei program at a school of its choosing. **RELATING TO EDUCATION.** EDU/TRE, WAM SB2349 Status and Testimony Requires the department of education to implement a pilot [Measure added on program to provide ten public school classrooms with air 2/2/2016] conditioning using a solar power system at each school; provided that each solar power system is powered by solar or photovoltaic panels and not connected to the electrical grid.
