Requires an interim report to be submitted before the 2017 regular session and the final study to be submitted before the 2018 regular session. Makes an appropriation. Effective 7/1/2016.	WAM
<u>SB 2089</u> <u>Status &amp;</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO A GENERAL EXCISE TAX EXEMPTION FOR LOW INCOME RENTAL SUBSIDIES. Exempts rental subsidy payments for Section 8 and Housing First Programs from the state general excise tax.	WAM
<u>SB 2299</u> <u>Status &amp;</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO STATE EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT. Creates a ten per cent state earned income tax credit. Requires reporting by department of taxation. Applies to taxable years beginning after 12/31/2016.	WAM
<u>SB 2454</u> <u>Status &amp;</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO TAXATION. Changes income tax rates after 12/31/2015.	WAM
