SB3095 RELATING TO TAXATION. WAM

Status and Testimony Exempts sales of services or tangible personal property to the

federal government from the general excise tax.

SB2089 RELATING TO A GENERAL EXCISE TAX EXEMPTION FOR WAM

Status and Testimony LOW INCOME RENTAL SUBSIDIES.

Exempts rental subsidy payments for Section 8 and Housing First

Programs from the state general excise tax.

SB2299 RELATING TO STATE EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT. WAM

Status and Testimony Creates a ten per cent state earned income tax credit. Requires

reporting by department of taxation. Applies to taxable years

beginning after 12/31/2016.

SB2454 RELATING TO TAXATION. WAM

Status and Testimony Changes income tax rates after 12/31/2015.

No testimony will be accepted.
