Requires the Department of Agriculture to develop and (SSCR3084) implement an Agricultural Food Safety Certification Program that concurrently complies with the FDA Food Safety Modernization Status & **Testimony** Act as it applies to farmers and ranchers. Authorizes and

appropriates funds for program staff. Effective 7/1/2112. (HD1)

HB 2657, HD2, SD1 RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. WLA, WAM

Amends the Molokai diversified agricultural revolving loan (SSCR2999) program established by Act 387, SLH 1988, to provide cost reimbursements to Molokai farmers and ranchers to reimburse Status & **Testimony** costs of mandated food safety compliance audits and other related costs. Appropriates funds to the Maui Office of

Economic Development to review and approve applications for the loan program. (SD1)

HB 1749, HD1, SD1 RELATING TO WATER MANAGEMENT. WLA/GVO, WAM

Amends the goals of the Hawaii water plan to include increased (SSCR3100) utilization of reclaimed water in all state facilities, where feasible.
