HB 1807, HD2 (SSCR2944) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO MILITARY SERVICE. Authorizes reserve and national guard members to receive paid military leave while on inactive-duty training. (HB1807 HD2)	PSM/JDL, WAM
HB 1753, HD3, SD1 (SSCR3061) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO MOPEDS. Requires registration, inspections, and number plates for mopeds. Requires all persons driving a moped to wear a safety helmet securely fastened with a chin strap. Effective 7/1/2030. (SD1)	TRE/PSM, WAM [Measure added on 04-06-16]
