Ann Greenlee is the Director, US Department of Labor, Veterans Employment and Training Service (VETS) for Hawaii and Guam. VETS serves as the focal point for veterans employment by preparing military service members for transition to civilian employment, providing veterans services to obtain meaningful careers, protecting their employment rights and promoting veteran hiring with employers.

Ms. Greenlee is a retired brigadier general with over 32 years of military service. Her last assignment was as the Assistant Adjutant General, Air, Headquarters, Hawaii National Guard. She ensured the readiness of forces in support of federal missions and executed homeland defense, defense support to civilian authorities, and other domestic emergency missions within the State of Hawaii. General Greenlee has been awarded the Department of Defense Legion of Merit, as well as the Hawaii Medal of Merit for outstanding service to the people of Hawaii.

Ms. Greenlee founded Hawaii Hires Heroes whose goal is to increase job opportunities for Hawaii's veterans and service members. She is the Vice Chairman of the Hawaii Committee for Employer Support of the Guard and Reserve and is the Chairperson of the Governor's Advisory Board on Veterans' Services. She serves as the Co-Chair of the US Veterans Administration, Hawaii State Veterans Advocacy Board and she is a member of the Hawaii Department of Education Adult Education Advisory Board.

Ms Greenlee graduated from Arizona State University. She earned a master's degree from George Washington University. She is a distinguished graduate of the US Air Force Air War College and the Department of Defense Joint Forces Staff College.
