<u>HB1734</u>	RELATING TO MARINE LIFE PROTECTION. Creates administrative penalties for any person who knowingly captures, kills, or takes any shark or ray within state marine waters. Provides exemptions for native Hawaiian gathering rights and cultural practices, research purposes, and public and personal safety.	OMH, JUD, FIN
