SB2312, SD1	RELATING TO THE PENAL CODE. Redefines "sexual conduct" as that term is used in the offenses of promoting child abuse in the first, second, and third degrees. Amends the definition of "sexual conduct" that applies to obscenity offenses to repeal references to homosexuality and lesbianism. Effective 1/7/2059. (SD1)	JUD
SB2314, SD1	RELATING TO THE OFFENSE OF ABUSE OF FAMILY OR HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS. Makes a person ineligible for a deferred acceptance of guilty plea or deferred acceptance of nolo contendere plea in cases where the person was originally charged with the offense of abuse of a family or household member and the charge is subsequently reduced to a lesser included offense. Effective 1/7/2059. (SD1)	JUD
