<u>HB1473</u>	RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE. Amends the permitted uses of campaign funds to include contributions to other candidate committees.	FIN
<u>HB2146</u>	RELATING TO WAILUKU PROPERTIES. Requires the department of accounting and general services to develop a Wailuku state office master plan to address the shortage of space in the Wailuku state office building and old courthouse building. Makes an appropriation for the master plan. Makes an appropriation for the purchase of certain other properties in Wailuku.	FIN
<u>HB2188, HD1</u>	RELATING TO HAWAII CORRECTIONAL INDUSTRIES. Authorizes Hawaii Correctional Industries to sell products and services on the open market to the general public. (HB2188 HD1)	PBS, FIN

HB2481, HD1 RELATING TO HEALTH.

HLT, FIN

Broadens the scope of health and health care data and other information submitted to SHPDA. (HB2481 HD1)

HB2617, HD1 RELATING TO LAND USE.

WAL, FIN

Requires the counties to petition LUC to reclassify lands. Requires LUC to conduct the five year regional boundary change review. (HB2617 HD1)

HB2618, HD1 RELATING TO WORKS OF ART SPECIAL FUND.

VMI, FIN

Deletes appropriations for capital renovations, as a source of funds for the Works of Art Special Fund. Requires 50% of the Special Fund expenditures to be used for art education at DOE schools effective July 1, 2050. Requires the Auditor to audit the Special Fund and the State Foundation on Culture and the Arts with respect to the price, value, and method of acquisition of the art objects purchased by the Special Fund. Appropriates funds for appraisal services. (HB2618 HD1)

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME FIN

LANDS.

Makes an appropriation for the appointment of an administrative monitor in the Office of the Auditor to assess the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands' progress in meeting its constitutional and

legal duties.
