Thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony in support of HB 1176, HD2, which urges the State of Hawaii to prohibit the sale of e-liquid containers for electronic smoking devices unless the container is child-resistant, and also prohibits the sale of electronic smoking devices unless they contain warning labels identifying the health hazards associated with use of these products.

Many current e-cigarette users have families with small children. Currently if young child obtains an e-liquid container they can easily open the container and orally consume the e-liquid, which could result in their death. By requiring child-resistant containers this health hazard could be potentially eliminated. In addition, many adolescents and young adults believe that e-cigarettes are not harmful to their health. Not knowing the true health hazards can lead to addiction and will have future negative health-related consequences for the young people of Hawaii.

Child-resistant containers and warning labels on all electronic smoking devices is an achievable solution that will save lives. Therefore, the Student Health Advisory Council strongly supports and urges the passing of HB 1176, HD2.
