Chair Rhoads, Vice-Chair Buenaventura and members of the House Committee on Judiciary, the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney of the City and County of Honolulu ("Department") submits the following testimony in <u>strong support</u> of House Bill 211. This is one of only two bills in the Department's 2015 Legislative Package.

The Department is requesting \$350,000 as a grant-in-aid for the Honolulu Family Justice Center. This public safety initiative will provide comprehensive services for victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking as well as long term transitional housing.
