Chair Nishihara, Vice Chair Espero, and members of the Committee.

The Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism <u>supports</u> this bill to amend Section 201-72.5 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes to reduce the number of Aerospace Advisory Committee members appointed by the Governor from fifteen to thirteen.

This measure will eliminate the investment banking representative from the Committee, which historically has been difficult to recruit, as well as enable the Committee to appoint its own chairman, rather than require the Governor to appoint another individual to serve in this capacity, thereby expediting the Committee Chairman selection process.
