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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AEROSPACE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. Section 201-72.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3       "(a) There is established an aerospace advisory committee  
4 within the office of aerospace development of the department of  
5 business, economic development, and tourism for administrative  
6 purposes. The committee shall be composed of [~~fifteen~~] thirteen  
7 members appointed by the governor, as provided in section 26-34,  
8 except as otherwise provided in this section. Of the [~~fifteen~~]  
9 thirteen members:

10       (1) Three members shall be representatives of the  
11 aerospace industry. One member shall be appointed  
12 from a list of nominees submitted by the president of  
13 the senate, and one member shall be appointed from a  
14 list of nominees submitted by the speaker of the house  
15 of representatives;

16       (2) Three members shall be representatives of the  
17 aerospace industry in this State. One member shall be

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1 appointed from a list of nominees submitted by the  
2 president of the senate, and one member shall be  
3 appointed from a list of nominees submitted by the  
4 speaker of the house of representatives;

7 ~~-(4)]~~ (3) Four members shall represent the economic  
8 development boards of Kauai, Oahu, Maui, and Hawaii,  
9 respectively, to be appointed, respectively, from a

13 Hawaii at Manoa, University of Hawaii at Hilo, and  
14 University of Hawaii community college system,  
15 respectively, to be appointed, one each, from a list  
16 of nominees submitted by the University of Hawaii at  
17 Manoa, University of Hawaii at Hilo, and University of  
18 Hawaii community college system, respectively~~[-and]~~.

JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT: Business, Economic Development, and Tourism

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE AEROSPACE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

PURPOSE: Reduce the number of members on the aerospace advisory committee from fifteen to thirteen by eliminating the investment banking representative and allowing the advisory committee to elect its own chairperson from members appointed by the Governor to serve on this body.

MEANS: Amend section 201-72.5(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: It has been difficult to find an investment banking representative willing to participate on the advisory committee, thus making it difficult to achieve quorum. Allowing the committee to appoint its own chairperson would expedite the committee chairperson appointment process.
