MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS

This measure is a vehicle bill to appropriate and authorize funding for collective bargaining cost items for salary adjustments and other cost adjustments for public employees represented by the Hawaii Government Employees Association belonging to Bargaining Unit 14 and their excluded counterparts for Fiscal Biennium 2015-17.

The Department of Budget and Finance supports this Administration proposal, or a similar one, to fund the arbitration award, which was issued February 22, 2016. It is noted that Act 55, SLH 2015, provided funding for the employees of this new bargaining unit as part of Bargaining Units 3 and 4. The attached proposed House Bill No. 2307, S.D. 1, amends Act 55, SLH 2015, to provide for the additional requirements.
