TESTIMONY ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2331, RELATING TO BOARD MEMBER TERMS FOR THE BOARD OF NURSING AND THE BOARD OF SPEECH PATHOLOGY AND AUDIOLOGY.

TO THE HONORABLE DELLA AU BELATTI, CHAIR, AND MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE:

My name is Celia Suzuki, Licensing Administrator for the Professional and

Vocational Licensing Division, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs

("Department"). The Department appreciates the opportunity to submit testimony in

strong support of this Administration bill, House Bill No. 2331.

The purpose of House Bill No. 2331 is to amend the terms of board members in

chapters 457 and 468E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, from three years to four years.

These amendments would align the terms of members of the Board of Nursing and the

board of Speech Pathology and Audiology with the terms of members serving on

twenty-three other boards and commissions under the Professional and Vocational Licensing Division.

The members of these two boards are the only members serving on one of the Professional and Vocational Licensing Division's twenty-five boards and commissions to not have the opportunity to serve out the regular maximum of two four-year terms. Longevity and continuity are also key for board members to learn and acclimate themselves in order to become effective board members. Finally, finding members who are willing to volunteer and give up time away from their "paying" jobs is often difficult. So individuals willing to devote the time and energy to being board members should be allowed ample time to serve.
