The Department of Transportation (DOT) provides **comments** on H.B. 2484 to conduct a Kunia Road safety study and determine the feasibility of installing an advance warning signal at the H-1 Freeway Exit 5A.

First, DOT confirms that we will continue to review and consider all state roadways to determine needed safety improvements as part of our Statewide safety program. Safety improvements will be implemented based on priority and available funds.

Second, DOT acknowledges the request for an advance warning signal at the H-1 Freeway Exit 5A. However, based on nationally accepted guidance and traffic incident reports, the additional warning signal is not necessary as the sight distance for visibility of the signal on Kunia Road is more than required.
