in consideration of HB 443 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO UPDATE AGRICULTURAL SOIL CLASSIFICATIONS AND MAPS.

Chair Evans, Vice Chair Cullen, and Members of the House Committee on Water and Land.

The Office of Planning (OP) supports the intent of HB 443, and respectfully offers the following comments. HB 443 would appropriate as much as \$2 million each fiscal year for Fiscal Years 2016 and 2017 for OP and the Land Use Commission (LUC) to update agricultural soil classifications and maps.

OP acknowledges long-standing concerns over the use of the Land Study Bureau (LSB) overall (master) productivity ratings in regulating land uses in the State Agricultural District. However, OP and the LUC lack the technical expertise or functional mandate with which to guide and implement this undertaking.

In view of the potentially significant expense of updating the agricultural soil productivity maps, it might be more cost-effective to examine how to better use the ongoing soils classification program of the U.S. Department of Agriculture and its National Farmland Inventory program in defining agricultural land capability in Hawaii. A less costly approach would be to examine whether there are alternative means to guiding and regulating use of agricultural lands than the use of the LSB rating system in Hawaii Revised Statutes Chapter 205. Thank you for the opportunity to testify on this measure.
