- Fiscal Implications: Appropriates an unspecified amount of general funds in fiscal years 2015-
- 2 2016 and 2016-2017. The measure requests an additional ambulance unit including a vehicle,
- 3 personnel, and equipment.
- 4 Department Testimony: The Department respectfully defers to the Governor's Executive
- 5 Budget request for the Department of Health's appropriations and personnel priorities.
- The Department recognizes the significant challenges to providing health care and
- 7 emergency services to the Kakaako Community. The Department is projecting a shortfall in
- 8 general funds to fund the existing ambulance contracts across the state for FY16 and FY17.
- 9 Funding an additional unit would have a negative impact on existing services.
- This measure seeks to augment the City and County emergency medical services system
- for the residents and visitors of the Kakaako area. The Honolulu City and County Emergency
- Medical Services currently operates 20 ground ambulances on the island of Oahu. The last unit
- added was Ewa Beach in fiscal year 2013. Honolulu City and County has budgeted funds to
- secure and administer a backup 911 contract with American Medical Response to aid with
- increased 911 calls.
