Chair Lee and Members of the Committee:

DESCRIPTION:

This measure requests the Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") to assess the feasibility and potential merits and benefits of the energy cooperative model for the island of Hawaii and report its findings to the Legislature prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2017.

POSITION:

The Commission opposes this measure and offers the following comments for the Committee's consideration.

COMMENTS:

The Commission notes that it would be inappropriate for the Commission to assess the feasibility and potential merits and benefits of the energy cooperative model for the island of Hawaii until an applicant provides the Commission with a proposal along with supporting details and analysis. As an adjudicatory agency, the Commission would be responsible for ruling on any potential proposal that the Hawaii Island Energy Cooperative ("HIEC"), or any another entity, files with the Commission. Publishing a report on the feasibility and potential merits and benefits of the energy cooperative model for the island of Hawaii could inadvertently limit the Commission's review of such a potential application

and may hinder existing regulatory processes and other adjudicatory functions of the Commission.

Additionally, the Commission finds it inappropriate to conduct this study because HIEC is currently an intervenor in the Commission's still pending docket regarding the transfer of control of the Hawaiian Electric Companies to NextEra Energy.

For these reasons, the Commission suggests that the Legislative Reference Bureau may be a more appropriate agency to study the feasibility and potential merits and benefits of the energy cooperative model for the island of Hawaii.
