

## SB1248 SD1 RELATING TO HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE

The Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA) <u>SUPPORTS</u> SB1248 SD1, which would contribute to the revitalization of the Hawaiian language by allowing the Hawaiian Language College at the University of Hawai'i at Hilo to increase its ability generate revenue and become more self-sustainable.

After the Hawaiian language nearly went extinct in the 1980s, programs such as the Hawaiian Language College have worked hard to revitalize and perpetuate 'Ōlelo Hawai'i, which is one of the few Native languages in the United States expected to survive to the middle of the 2st century. The advances made to revitalize the Hawaiian language have been significant; however, the task of reintegrating and normalizing 'Ōlelo Hawai'i into the daily lives of Hawai'i's residents is far from complete.

As a primary provider of Hawaiian language materials and services, it is essential that the Hawaiian Language College be provided with increased revenue-generating opportunities, as the demand for its services grows with continuing revitalization efforts. The college has received requests to support external entities (both inside and outside Hawai'i) for translation and other services. However, the College is currently restricted from charging for services and products other than solely Hawaiian language books. Instead, if they choose to provide the services they must do it for free or seek alternative funding. If they are able to generate more revenue they will be able to continue and increase its foundational role in the movement to revitalize 'Ōlelo Hawai'i, and provide services such as: Hawaiian language class curricula; the development of Hawaiian educational materials, including assessment tools; teacher trainings; family workshops; book and alternative media publications; the creation and maintenance of online Hawaiian repositories; and research and development of modern Hawaiian vocabulary.

SB1248 SD1 will accordingly allow the Hawaiian Language College to continue and expand its efforts in language revitalization locally, nationally, and internationally, by allowing the college to generates revenue through its services.

OHA therefore urges the Committee to PASS SB1248 SD1.
